Did you know that bees pollinate over 130 different agricultural crops in Canada and the US each year?

Bee pollination accounts for \$14 billion annually in improved crop yield and quality.



On March 11, 2024, the province of PEI introduced a new service to streamline the permit process – an online permit application service for some property developments. This service is applicable to build accessory structures like decks and sheds on your properties. The benefit? Instant Approval.

Outlined in the details, to qualify, decks must be less than 592 sq ft and less than 24" above the ground, and sheds are to less than 215 sq ft or less and not connected to power or water.

For those curious as to 'why' permits are to be purchased prior to constructing a deck or shed on your property, the simple answer is Your Safety.

The province, and your municipality want to ensure that structures are planned, designed, and built in a safe and sound manner, compliant with island regulations and municipal bylaws.
